Lawn care feature in Lynda Snell's garden

- To prevent scorching caused by your pet dog's urine:
Adding charcoal tables to your dog's water bowl will neutralize the acidity of their urine.
- Be careful not to cut lawn too short in the spring in order to protect it from last frosts
- Use a fork to aerate the soil and prevent compaction

- Use a Spring Tine rake to scarify lawn – collect up all thatch (moss, dead grass etc)
