A carpet bedding scheme to commemorate the 800th anniversary of the sealing of Magna Carta articles by King John of England. This "Great Charter" was part of the process that led to the rule of constitutional law in England and is central in the bedding scheme. The bed is surrounded by bolder plants (Cordyline 'Red Star') and materials representing the Barons who aimed to bring the monarch to heel.

A traditional bedding scheme has been modernised, taking the design from paper to computer. Thereafter InstaPlant® pre-rooted tiles of plants have been used to simplify the previously labour intensive tasks of growing and planting out (www.instaplant.co.uk).
